Planning Board Public Hearing on Proposed Amendments
To the Town's Zoning Bylaws

The Town of Abington Planning Board will hold a public hearing pursuant to G.L. c. 40A, §5 on April 3, 2017 at 6:10 P.M. at Abington Town Hall, 500 Gliniewicz Way, Abington Massachusetts 02351. The purpose of the public hearing is to provide interested parties with an opportunity to comment on the following proposed amendments to the Town of Abington's Zoning Bylaws: to amend the Flood Plain and Wetlands Protection District Zoning Bylaw, §175-35, to clarify the roles of the Planning Board and Board of Appeals in reviewing plans for construction in said zoning district; adding a new provision to impose a temporary moratorium on uses of land for non-medical/recreational marijuana establishments; adding a new definition of the term "exterior architectural appearance" and amending relevant provisions of the zoning bylaws to incorporate this new definition into plan review for certain types of development; amending the definition of the term "Apartment"; and amending the Use Table with respect to locations in which Tattoo Parlors will be allowed.
