

On Tuesday, October 8, 2013 at 7:00 p.m. in the Cotter Room, Abington Town Hall, 500 Gliniewicz Way, the Abington Conservation Commission will hold a hearing on the 2013 Abington Open Space and Recreation Plan.

Abington has 1886 acres of fully or partially protected open space. Open space resources, including conservation and recreation areas are important to the Town of Abington for providing active and passive opportunities for recreational activities. They are key resources in our water supply and environment, protected in part by the Wetlands Protection Act and Town Bylaw. This plan is updated every 5 years.

It is being prepared by James R. Watson, of the Old Colony Planning Council for the Town. Residents of Abington will hear of the Open Space inventory, which includes conservation and town-owned lands and ball parks. They will be able to make suggestions and give input on the priorities of the plan.
