Subj: Griffins Dairy

The Board of Selectmen will be holding a special meeting on Monday, December 15, 2014 at 6:30 p.m. at the Cotter Room at Town Hall to hear input from members of the community regarding possible future use of the property on 326 Plymouth commonly known as Griffins Dairy. The Board of Selectmen has made a request to our regional planning agency, Old Colony Planning Council, to perform a "master plan" of the site to help the town determine options for the best use(s) of the property. In order for OCPC to do its job properly it is important for the Board to hear and document concerns, needs, and ideas.

Please be advised that there is no plan for the Board of Selectmen to vote on the future of the site at this time but only to provide a forum for themselves and the public. Although this meeting is not a formal public hearing, Chairman Ken Coyle has asked that any person, either representing himself or a group, that wishes to make comments at the meeting to contact the Town Manager's Office to get placed on a list of expectant speakers in order to help him plan the course of the meeting. While this will not likely preclude others from making comments it is helpful in planning the conduct of the meeting.
