They will start with power washing on Monday as soon as they get the bladder down, then the staging. They will give 48 hour notice to the Commission before using chemicals.

Continued hearing, NOI, David Aylward, 1066 Washington Street, Abington, to re-establish swales to correct drainage problem in backyard at 1066 Washington Street. New Business:

Request for Certificate of Compliance, #84-131, 12 Hemlock Lane, Allison Moody. They bought the house last year, and at that time they found a certificate of compliance had never been issued. They went ahead with the sale anyway. They contacted the developer who said it was built per the order of conditions. There had been a Request for Determination on this lot, with a negative determination for the construction of the house. The order of conditions is still open for the roadway and the layout of the subdivision and drainage. They are requesting a partial certificate of compliance on this lot.

Motion to issue a Partial Certificate of Compliance for Lot 4A, #12 Hemlock Lane, made by Jerry, seconded by Bill, unanimous.
