Meeting Minutes

May 11, 2015

The meeting was brought to order at 7PM by Chairman Richard Donovan, with Carolyn Bates, William Kendall, and Lurane Ryerson in attendance. Chad Lovett in absentia.

The meeting minutes of February 23, 2015 were read and unanimously approved.

It was noted that the NOI (Notice of Intent) has been filed by the Town Manager with the Conservation Commission. That committee has approved the NOI. The clerk will obtain a copy of the minutes of that meeting for our packet.

There was discussion concerning the demolition of the farmhouse and the barn. The area remains fenced in and there has been grass sown. The Community garden is underway with plowing and fencing. It has been enlarged.

The Farmer's Market will not take place at the dairy this year. A place for it has yet to be determined.

OCPC decision/recommendations is due sometime in June for the use of the Griffin's property.

Mr. Donovan mentioned the issue about mowing. Nothing has been done this Spring to date.

Bill Kendall and Carolyn Bates will question the Asst. Town Manager about what happens when a Bond is satisfied and property is involved.
