Meeting Minutes

December 14, 2015

The meeting was brought to order by Vice –Chairman William Kendall at 7PM with Carolyn Bates and Lurane Ryerson in attendance. In absentia, Richard Donovan.

Others present were; Katie Marini, Michael Pratt, Jenny Brown, and Terry Maize. The meeting minutes of May 11, 2015 were read and unanimously approved.

It was noted that the Farmer's market was held at the Abington Senior Center July – October, being less successful than at the Griffin's Dairy location.

The community garden was successful and well maintained.

The fields were completely mowed and baled once during the summer by John Hornstra of Norwell. No cost to the town.

Discussion was held on the location of the proposed Soccer/Lacrosse fields in respect to their proximity to the gardens. Safety issues for the players, gardeners, and plantings being of prime concern.

Another point of concern is the use of pesticides/chemicals to prepare the soil/grass for sport usage. Jack Kane manages this.

The Park and Recreation Commission will meet on Wednesday, Dec. 16, 2015. They will hopefully have the latest delineation of the Griffin's fields.

The clerk will meet with the Assistant Town Manager concerning the vacant seat on the committee, and will also inquire as to what happens to property when a Bond Issue is satisfied.

The meeting was adjourned by Mr. Kendall, seconded by Mrs. Bates with a unanimous Vote at 8:10 PM.
